CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRIES

Entries will close on 14 September 2007. The tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating its reasons and that decision shall be final. If the appropriate entry fee does not accompany the application it must be paid by 14 September 2007. Refunds of entry fees will not be permitted after 14 September 2007.

ELIGIBILITY

Male entrants must be a financial member of an affiliated Veteran Golfers Association and hold a current AGU handicap. The tournament is open to amateur golfers born prior to 5-11-1952. Female entrants must have a verified WGU handicap. Current membership and Golf Link/handicap cards showing exact handicap must be produced at registration.

HANDICAP

The maximum handicap for men is 27 and women 45. Handicaps at the start of the tournament shall remain unchanged for the tournament, but the match committee reserves the right to re-handicap for daily events. To assist in sending results to your home club, please supply the club's Email address.

GRADES/DRAW

The tournament committee will decide the handicap limits in A, B and C grades when entries have been finalized. Women will play in two grades of approximately equal numbers.

RULES

The rules will be those as approved by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited and USGA., and any local rules set down by the various clubs. Any protest must be lodged with the Match Committee within 15 minutes of conclusion of the player's round and the dispute or decision of the Match Committee shall be final and binding.

EVENT

The championship shall be played as a 36 hole stroke event. In the event of a tied score the winner will be determined by a play off. All other tied scores will be decided by countback. Women's events will be two individual 18 hole stableford events. Tied scores will be decided by count back.

Players must report to the starter 20 minutes before their designated tee-off time. The starter has the right to reschedule any player's tee time, however breach of Rule 6.3a is disqualification. In the absence of circumstances, which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33.7, the penalty will be two strokes instead of disqualification.

Scorecards must be in the hands of the card checkers no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the relevant round. No player may collect more than one major trophy.

DRESS CODE

All players must be correctly attired. Shirts must have collar and be tucked in at the waist,. Trousers, slacks and shorts should be tailored. Jeans are not permitted attire. Sports socks must be predominately white and fully extended. Dress for the presentation dinner is smart casual.

LIABILITY

All courses have their own liability insurance. It is the responsibility of any visiting golfer to ensure they have the necessary Personal Liability cover for protection against Third Party Personal Injury or damage to Property. Under duty of care responsibility the health declaration on the entry form needs to be completed as the tournament committee is required to be aware of any competitor's pre-existing medical condition.
