CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Event: Consists of 4 Championships (Open, Junior, B Grade and Senior Masters) to be played over 36 holes stroke play.

Match Committee: The Match Committee shall consist of selected members of DGA Match Committee and/or Host Club Match Committee. The Match Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Championships with full power at any time, to alter or vary any of the conditions.

Eligibility: The Event is open to male amateur golfers who are members of a golf club affiliated with the ACT-Monaro District Golf Association. The Junior Championship and Senior Masters Championship are restricted to players who meet the respective age requirement of: Juniors (under 18 years of age as at 21 November 2010) and Senior Masters (aged 50 years and over as at 21 November 2010).

Handicap limit: A maximum GA handicap limit of 20.4 shall apply. Players with higher handicap may enter, but must play off a handicap of 20.

Entries: Entries are limited to a maximum field of 90 players. Places will be allocated in order of receipt of entry. The Match Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.

Ties: In the event of a tie or ties for any of the 4 Championships (A Grade, Junior, B grade and Senior Masters - 36 Holes Gross), unless the Match Committee otherwise determines, a **sudden death play-off** will apply from the 1st tee continuing until a result is reached, with players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined. All other ties will be decided using the GA count-back system.

Trophies: A Junior may win the Junior Championship and A Grade or B Grade Championship. A Senior Master may win the Senior Master Championship and A Grade or B Grade Championship. All other players are limited to win only one trophy.

Trophies will be allocated in the following order based on value:

- 36 Holes Gross (A Grade, Junior, B Grade and Senior Masters) – winner & runners-up for each Championship
- 36 Holes Gross (A Grade, B Grade) – Third
- 36 Holes Net (A Grade, Junior, B Grade and Senior Masters) – winners per Championship
- 18 Holes: (A & B Grade) Round 1 Gross winner; Round 2 Gross winner;
- 18 Holes : Round 1 Nett Winner; Round 2 Nett winner

If Sufficient entries

- 18 Holes: Nett winners and Runner-ups in A & B Grade
- 18 Holes: (A & B Grade) Round 1 Gross runner-up; Round 2 Gross runner-up

Motorised transport: Permissible for all players.
