2010 MOSS VALE GOLF CLUB CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries strictly close on Friday the 19TH of November 2010. The draw will be available on Tuesday the 22nd of November 2010 at www.jnig.com.au or emailed to those who have provided their email address.
2. If you fax your entry forms without the credit card details they will not be accepted until payment is received.
3. Entries may close prior to the closing date if the tournament is declared full.
4. A ballot may be required depending on the size of the field at the closing date. A minimum of 8 entries is required to constitute an age division. If insufficient entries are received players will move up to the next age division.
5. If competitors do not have a Golf Link Number they must submit a 3 month handicap report with the entry. The 3 month handicap report must be endorsed by their home club official. If you fail to do so, your entry will be returned and your position in the field is not guaranteed. This condition applies to all players in the 18 hole stroke and 9 hole hcp divisions.
6. All competitors who have a Golf Link Number must provide it on their entry form. If you fail to do so, your entry will be returned and your position in the field is not guaranteed. This condition applies to players in the 18 hole stroke and 9 hole hcp divisions.
7. Caddies are permitted. Caddies must respect the rights of the competitors at all times. Caddies, whether they be parents or friends are reminded to avoid placing unnecessary pressure on the competitors. **NO ADVICE SHOULD BE GIVEN TO A COMPETITOR BY A CADDY UNLESS REQUESTED. CADDIES SHOULD NOT CRITICISE THE DECISIONS OR EFFORTS OF A COMPETITOR AT ANY STAGE DURING THE TOURNAMENT.** The Match Committee reserves the right of any caddy rights of any person who it believes is not acting in the best interest of the competitor.
8. Entry implies acceptance of the Conditions of Play governing the tournament and the Match Committee of Moss Vale Golf Club reserves the right to alter the Tournament's Conditions of Play without prior notice.
9. The Tournament shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew, together with such local rules as are applicable on the golf course. Any rule or decision made by the Match Committee of Moss Vale Golf Club shall be final.
10. Any player who has his golf playing membership or handicap at the date of the contest suspended by Golf NSW, any Club who is a member of Golf NSW, or District Golf Association, is not eligible to participate.
11. No Smoking or Drinking of alcohol is permitted by any player or caddy at the golf club/course during the duration of the tournament. **NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED ON THE COURSE.**
12. Once the draw is completed, no refund will be available except upon production of a medical certificate.
13. The Match Committee of Moss Vale Golf Club reserves the right to refuse entry to any person without being required to give reason to do so.
14. The Match Committee of Moss Vale Golf Club will control all competitions and its decision in any dispute is final.

15. Any protest(s) must be made to the Match Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play. The decision of the Match Committee shall be final.
16. The Match Committee will strictly enforce 'Pace of Play' rulings. Each group Must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Penalties WILL be issued to individuals in groups who by their pace of play contribute to such delay. Warnings will not necessarily be issued. REMEMBER YOUR PLACE IN THE FILED IF DIRECLTY BEHIND THE GROUP IN FRONT NOT IN FRONT OF THE GROUP BEHIND.
17. Players must start at the times set down by the Committee. If a player arrives after his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start is disqualification. Players are required to report to registration a minimum of 30 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
18. Players and Caddies will not be permitted to ride on or in any form of transportation during play, unless authorised by the Match Committee. Request for a waiver must be submitted with the entry form.
19. A player must return their scorecard to the designated scoring area. Each player must check their scorecards with their markers in the designated scoring area. Only players are allowed in the designated scoring area.
20. Sand buckets must be carried and used and returned to the appropriate place at conclusion of play. All divots and pitch marks must be repaired by the player. FAILURE TO REPAIR DIVOTS AND PITCH MARKS OR CARRY A SAND BUCKET WILL RESULT IN A TWO SHOT PENATLY AND OR DISQUALIFICATION FOR REPEATED OFFENCES.
21. Inappropriate language and bad behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Bad behaviour includes throwing or mistreating their own or fellow players equipment.
22. Use of mobile phones on the course by a player, caddie or spectator are prohibited.
23. Artificial measuring devices are NOT permitted.

**2010 MOSS VALE GOLF CLUB JUNIOR OPEN DRESS REGULATIONS
DRESS REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED**

BOYS

Pants / Shorts

Tailored long pants or shorts may be worn
Shorts must not sit below the bottom of the knee
Shorts are not permitted to be higher than mid thigh
Cargo shorts are not permitted

Shirts

Collared shirts must be worn and tucked in at all times

Socks

Players are permitted to wear ankle and calf length socks with shorts
Socks worn with shorts must be predominately white in colour and ankle socks must be clearly visible above a players' shoe line

GIRLS

Pants / Shorts

Tailored pants, skirts or shorts may be worn
Shorts / Skirts higher than mid thigh are not permitted

Shirts

Collared shirts must be worn
Shirts that expose the midriff are not allowed

Socks

Ankle socks may be worn as long as they are white in colour

CADDIES

All Caddies must adhere to the above dress regulations. The right to caddy will be revoked if a caddy does not adhere to the above dress regulations.

SPECTATORS

All Spectators that set foot on the Golf Course must adhere to the above dress regulations. All Spectators that remain in the clubhouse must adhere to the Moss Golf Club dress regulations.
