# Capital Golf Club – Open Championship

## Competition Conditions

**The Committee.** The Capital Open will be conducted under the control of the Capital Golf Club Men's Committee. The Committee may vary these conditions if deemed necessary, and decisions of the Committee will be final.

**Eligibility.** The Capital Open is open to all amateur golfers who hold a valid Golf Australia Handicap.

**Format.** The event is 36 holes stroke play. Any tie for Open Champion or for Junior Champion will be decided by sudden death play off on holes to be determined by the Committee. All other tied scores will be determined by count back. The field will be divided into two approximately equal divisions on the basis of handicaps of entrants after entries close. (Typically, the cut off between divisions is about 12 handicap.)

**Method of Entry.** Eligible golfers may enter by lodging the provided entry form with Capital Golf Club, accompanied by the relevant entry fee, by mail or other means before the prescribed closing time.

**Entry Fee.** The entry fee is as indicated on the flyer (ie, \$35, \$20 for Juniors). Entry fee must be lodged with application (No daily entries allowed).

**Tee Off Times - General.** Tee off times will be from 8:30 am to 12:00 noon. In general, tee off times will be the same both days except for the seeded group on the second day, and minor adjustments to fit in with the seeded group. This could involve a non-seeded player having a tee off time on the second day one group earlier than first day. Accordingly, golfers should report to the starter 20 minutes before expected tee off time on the second day.

**Tee Off Times - Seedings.** On the second day the three or four players with the leading gross scores will be seeded and will tee off about 11am. The number of seeded players will be determined when the size of the field is known. Seeded players must play in the seeded group, unless prior approval is given by the Club Captain or Men's Captain. *Penalty disqualification.*

**Tee Off Times – Choice of Time.** Golfers may indicate their preference for an early, middle or late tee off time. The cut-off time between each range will be determined by the numbers nominating each range of tee off times.

**Handicaps.** Throughout the competition, golfers will play off their Golf Australia Handicaps (ie, maximum 36) as at the beginning of the competition. Evidence of handicap must be provided to the Committee on request.

**Prizes.** Prizes will be awarded as indicated, and in the order listed, on the flyer. Apart from nearest the pins and ball competitions, no player may receive more than one award.

**Ride-on Motorised Carts.** Ride-on motorised carts may be used only with the prior approval of the Committee, on medical grounds. *Penalty disqualification.*

**Mobile Telephones, Radios, CD players or similar devices.** Mobile telephones etc may not be used on the course during the competition. *Penalty disqualification.*

**AGU's Doping Policy.** Competitors are subject to drug testing as laid down by the GA's Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this condition, or refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.

**Rules.** The event will be conducted under the Rules as defined in the Rules of Golf. *Under Rule of Golf 6-1, the player is responsible for knowing the Rules under which the event is to be played.*
